

FIRST CLASS YACHT GALAPAGOS

PACKAGES CRUISES GALAPAGOS. - The tour is to stay as long as possible sailing between islands (you get to sleep on the boats, yachts, sailboats or catamarans every night) for 4 days, 5 days, 6 days, 7 days, 8 days or 15 days. Outputs any day depending on the itinerary of the vessel. You choose the kind of economic boat (10 to 12 passengers), superior tourist (16 passengers), First Class (16 or 40 passengers) and luxury (16, 40, 100 or more passengers). Galaeco takes care of the flight booking. Scuba-diving service is only offered with land tours and it previous notice (passengers should present and update diving certificate). Regarding tips: It depends on you but normally it is \$20 for the guide and \$30 for the rest of the crew, but in some boats they will tell you what is acceptable.

In the Packages cruises included:

Lodging in the yacht of your choice, three complete meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner with drinks), free drinks tea, coffee and a bottle of pure water that you can refill all the time, towels, transfers to the islands by public transportation, excursions on the islands, naturalist English-speaking guide.

In the Packages cruises do not included:

Entrance to the National Park Galapagos (\$105 per person, to be paid in cash in Galapagos), Pre-pay Fees Transit Control Card (\$20 per person, to be paid in cash in Galapagos), Entrance to Isabela Island \$20 per person, extra drinks (soda, alcoholic drinks), extra expenses, snorkeling equipment (for rent on board), Wetsuit (for rent on board), diving, tips, lodging in Quito or in other cities, transfers in Quito \$50 for two people per way), extra expenses and airplane ticket \$520 per person Quito - Galapagos - Quito / \$490 per person Guayaquil - Galapagos - Guayaquil (If the airline raises the price, we will charge you extra).

ENTERPRISE'S POLICIES (WAYS OF PAYMENT)

- 1. Reservations are US\$500 per person.
- 2. The passenger must pay 50% of the tour price 4 months prior the starting date.
- 3. The full price must be canceled 3 months in advanced. (Payments may be made by bank transfers or credit card Visa -Mastrecard 9% more).

CANCELLING POLICY

- 1. If the passenger cancels the tour 5 months prior the starting date the passenger will forfeit \$80 per person to cover the cost of cancellation.
- 3. If the passenger cancels the tour 5 months prior the starting date the passenger will forfeit 50 % of the tour price cover the cost of cancellation.
- 4. If the passenger cancels the tour 4 months prior the starting date the passenger will forfeit 100% of the tour price. cover the cost of cancellation.

For cancellations, the passenger will be refunded based on the net amount paid to GALAECO Tour Operator, without the bank fees or any other extra taxes.



WHEN PURCHASING A TOUR, THE PASSENGER AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING:

- **A)** In the event the intended yacht is unable to continue with the cruise, it is the responsibility of GALAECO Tour Operator to provide another yacht that is able to do so.
- **B)** The standard fare includes the sharing of a double cabin with another passenger, who could be of the opposite sex. If a Client wishes to have a cabin for himself, he must pay 2 times the standard fare according the yacht policies.
- **C)** If for any reason the agreed to number of days of the cruise cannot be completed, the client will be entitled to a refund proportional to the number of days not completed, based on the amount paid to GALAECO Tour Operator. There will not be a total refund unless the tour is completely cancelled.
- **D)** If for any reason GALAECO Tour Operator cancels the tour, the passenger will be fully refunded based on the amount paid to GALAECO Tour Operator, without any further claim.
- **E)** There will not refund for missed or unused services. If the client misses the flight to the island for any reason, the passenger will be responsible for paying his own transportation and any other expenses incurred in reaching the yacht.
- **F)** Upon booking the tour, the client agrees that the operator is not responsible for any accident in wish the client is harmed.
- **G)** GALAECO Tour Operator is not responsible for any luggage lost on the way to aboard the yacht. Any items of value should be entrusted to the care of the captain of the yacht, with the value of each item indicated.
- **H)** If for any reason the departure date is changed, the client will accept the changed date otherwise be entitled to a refund based on the amount paid to GALAECO Tour Operator.
- I) It is understood that the itinerary and type of embarkation may be subject to alteration without prior notice due to local circumstances or events which may include sickness or mechanical breakdown, flight cancellations, strikes, climate and other unpredictable or unforeseeable circumstances.
- **J)** GALAECO Tour Operator will do its best to minimize the effects of matters outside its control but can not accept any liability for these matters which include strikes, delayed flights, climate, etc.
- **K)** It is the client responsibility to obtain sufficient personal travel insurance. The purchase of the tour confirms that the client has his own travel insurance, though he does not explicitly declare this.
- **L)** If a client has a complaint against the company, the client must first inform it to the administrator or company representative on board in order that the administrator / representative can attempt to rectify the matter.
